At the heart of these applications is their exclusive access to Motorola's NAI (Network Application Interface) for voice: a wireline voice and control interface that connects directly to the infrastructure of the MOTOTRBO radio network. While the control station architecture is cost-effective for applications deployed in smaller, simpler systems, the NAI interface offers better functionality and scale for larger systems.
